## **Howells-Dodge Consolidated Schools**

Howells-Dodge Consolidated Schools is one of the newest districts in Nebraska. The communities and former districts of Howells and Dodge joined in consolidation in 2011, with its first year as a consolidated district in 2012-2013. Presently the district serves <u>311</u> PK-12 students, with attendance centers in both communities. The communities of Howells and Dodge also support Catholic Parochial Elementary Schools with a total of approximately 60 to 65 students.

The Howells-Dodge district has a total valuation of \$1,040,529,319. The current total tax levy is \$0.476996 cents. The district has kept the levy under 60 cents for the last 9 budget cycles and at the same time making many improvements to district facilities, including a new addition to the Dodge Elementary Building.

The Howells-Dodge Board of Education is very supportive in the continuation of providing a quality education for the children of the district while maintaining fiscal responsibility. Howells-Dodge Consolidated Schools is truly a great school, committed to the quest of becoming a better school for the future of the children served in the district.
